(Summary) (c)**

At its meeting on 18/06/2019, the Council's Cabinet approved publication of a statutory proposal for the expansion and re-location of Lisburne School.

The Cabinet also agreed to delegate the final decision to the Deputy Chief Executive, subject to their being no significant objections. The statutory proposal was published on Wednesday 26/06/2019 and the subsequent representation period ended on Tuesday 23/07/2019. A total of five representations were received which largely repeat concerns about traffic and parking in the locality, which will be addressed as part of the Planning application and highways proposals that are designed to mitigate any impact as part of the proposed new scheme.

The Deputy Chief Executive has therefore considered a report detailing the outcomes and has approved the following proposals, without modification, subject to the grant of planning permission under Part 3 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, by 31st December 2020:

- Increase the number of places available at the School from the current number of 109 to 208 for children aged 4-11, following the re-location;
- Re-locate the School from Half Moon Lane to a larger newly constructed building on the former Offerton School site from September 2021.
